AND BACK LOG VACANCIES IN TSWR INSTITUTIONS FOR CLASSES VI TO IX FOR THE
ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18**

To provide special coaching to the meritorious Scheduled Caste students for the academic year 2017-18, the applications are invited from Boys and Girls for Admission into 8th and 9th classes at Centre of Excellence, Karimnagar(Co-Education), Karimnagar District and backlog vacancies from classes VI to IX in TSWR Institutions functioning under the control of TSWREI Society,

The applications will be received through online from **27.05.2017** and will be closed on **07.06.2017** and the date of Entrance Examination is **18.06.2017 at 11:00 AM.**

Date of downloading the Hall Tickets is 08.06.2017

Eligibility requirements: The eligibility criteria for admission into classes – VI to IX in TSWR Institutions and COE Karimnagar are mentioned as under :

A) Age: Class wise eligible age details are as follows :

| S.No | Class | SC & ST | Other Castes |

| 1 | VI | Not exceeding 14 years as on 31.08.2017 | Not exceeding 12 years as on 31.08.2017 |
| 2 | VII | Not exceeding 15 years as on 31.08.2017 | Not exceeding 13 years as on 31.08.2017 |
| 3 | VIII | Not exceeding 16 years as on 31.08.2017 | Not exceeding 14 years as on 31.08.2017 |
| 4. | IX | Not exceeding 17 years as on 31.08.2017 | Not exceeding 15 years as on 31.08.2017 |

- The students should have studied in a recognized school, either in Telugu Medium or English Medium.
- The students should produce caste and income certificates, certified by the Tahasildar and also other certificates required if any like bonafide, Aadhar , handicapped in case of PH etc all to be produced at the time of admission
- The parental income should be **Rs.1,50,000/-** in Rural areas and **Rs.2,00,000/-** in Urban areas per Annum.

C) Reservation : The reservation pattern for filling admissions in COE Karimnagar(Co-Education)

- In SC Category, 70% seats are reserved for students from TSWR Institutions and SW hostels and 30% to SC students from any other recognized institutions. **(8th and 9th classes of COE Karimnagar Only)**
- The seats under BC-C Converted Christians, ST, BC and OC are filled based on the merit only. **(8th and 9th classes of COE Karimnagar Only)**
- 3% of overall seats will be reserved to the Physically handicapped children for admissions into COE based on the certificate issued by the Medical Board for the students . They should be able to attend to their duties on their own. **(8th and 9th classes of COE Karimnagar Only)**
- In remaining TSWR Schools the admissions will be taken up based on availability of vacancies.

D) Submission of Applications and Entrance Examination Centers :-

All the students who are seeking admission into VIII and IX classes for the year 2017-18 into COE Karimnagar and the students who are seeking admissions into VI to IX class in other TSWR Schools of backlog vacancies should apply through online from **27.05.2017**.

Details of examination and syllabus :

- The questions will be of objective type and will be both in English and Telugu Medium.
- OMR sheets will be provided to answer the questions. The students have to bubble the answer in the OMR sheet with a blue/black ball point pen only.
- The syllabus for the examination is as follows :

- The applicants have to submit the application through online available in the society website www.tswreis.telangana.gov.in by visiting any Meeseva Kendra or any internet centre. There is no registration or application fee for submission of online applications.
- The Girls and Boys from all Districts in Telangana State can apply for admission into COE Karimangar for classes VIII and IX as it is Co-Education.
- The candidates should select "concerned class in online application (Ex. VI class / VII class / VIII class / IX class) and submit it through online.
- In other TSWR Schools the Boys will be provided admission in boys schools and girls in girls schools.
- Candidates are advised to take printout of filled in application form and download the Hall ticket from 08.06.2017 to 10.06.2017.
- Test will be conducted on 18.06.2017 at the centre Name mentioned in the hall ticket at 11:00 AM.

- Minimum qualifying marks in the Entrance Test will be 40% for Maths, 40% for Science, 40% for English and 25% for Current affairs & aptitude/Mental Ability.
- The selection of candidates will be purely on written test merit only.
- Only those candidates will be selected who have secured 40% marks in each of the subject and 25% marks in Current affairs/Mental Ability and aptitude and passed **V to VIII classes** in the academic year 2016-17 respectively.
- The candidates should attend the counseling on the scheduled dates and centres.
- The selected students will be allotted to the districts from which they have completed their previous classes.
- In case of any issues related to the interpretation of admission guidelines, the decision of the Secretary will be final before and after the admission process.
