ADMISSION IN TMR SCHOOLS

I. HOW TO SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION.

- 1. The eligible candidates can submit his/her application through online by visiting TMREIS website tmreistelangana.cgg.gov.in or through Mobile App in prescribed format from any internet centre or any TMR Institution or TMREIS Helpline centre (040-23437909) of TMREIS.
- 2. The submission process of online application will start from 17-01-2024 and the Last date for submission of online application is 06-02-2024.
- 3. Offline application can also be obtained from any TMR Institution and duly filled in application can be submitted to the concerned Principal directly for uploading it to the TMREIS website.
- 4. Before submission of ONLINE Application, the candidates should go through the prospectus and application format by visiting TMREIS Official website tmreistelangana.cgg.gov.in
- 5. While filling the application form the candidate should ensure that his/her name, date of birth, category (religion/caste), Class and Name of the school where he/she is seeking admission, gender, parent's phone number etc. are correctly filled. In order to avoid any mistakes, before filling the online application, the candidates can fill a sample application form given at Annexure- A and after verifying the details, the online application can be filled and submitted.
- Upload the Passport size photo and signature of the candidate within 100 Kb size only.
- 7. Option of School for admission in Class V: The candidate can opt any one TMR School in his/her native erstwhile district for admission. Boys should opt boys TMR School and Girls should opt girls TMR School in his /her native Erstwhile District.
- 8. Option of TMR School for admission in Class VI, VII or VIII (Minorities Category only): The candidate should opt any TMR School in

his/her native erstwhile district where the vacancies in minorities category are available. Boys should opt boys TMR School and Girls should opt girls TMR School.

- 9. There is no ONLINE registration fee.
- 10. There is no scope for change of any particulars after submission of ONLINE application.

Admission of candidates against the vacancies is based on First cum First served i.e. Time & Date of submission of application subject to the eligibility as per TMREIS norms and submission of all the documents like Aadhaar card, TC, Bonafide & Date of Birth certificate, Income certificate and Physical disability, orphan, children of ex-servicemen (if applicable) and Medically fit duly following the Reservation Matrix prescribed by the Society at the time of admission process.
- 2. The parents of the applicants will be called in the order of date & time of submission of application i.e. First cum first served as per the vacancies available as per the schedule with all the relevant certificates/documents as mentioned above to finalise the admission. In this regard, Principal will communicate well in advance the date & time of admission to the Parents through phone call or SMS.

- 3. The no. of parents of online candidates called for admission will not be more than the no. of vacancies available in the respective category.
- 4. The Parents who report for admission of their wards will be given token numbers for verification of certificates and documents.
- 5. After the verification of documents, the original documents of the eligible candidates would be retained by the school and the Principal will issue confirmation letter for admission to the parents with a direction to bring their wards on reopening day to admit in the hostel.
- 6. The parents who failed to fulfil the eligibility criteria during the admission process, their candidature for admission will be cancelled and the vacancies will be filled by calling the parents of the online candidates of the next order. IX. ADMISSION PROCESS:

- 1. Admission process will start immediately after declaration of SSC Results of Telangana State.
- 2. Priority to TMREIS Students for admission: Priority will be given to the TMREIS students subject to their eligibility. After admission of TMREIS Students, the left over vacancies will be filled with Non-TMREIS Students who have submitted their online applications duly following the Rule of reservation of TMREIS.

- 2. Students will be informed time, date and venue well in advance to attend the oral interview.
- Candidates have to attend the venue of TMR Schools on time either with escort teacher or parents. No TMREIS student should be sent alone by viewing safety & security of the students.
- 4. Principals of TMR School for Girls must take all precautionary measure while sending students for technical round by viewing their safety and security as per the Norms of TMREIS
- 5. Candidates will be asked questions orally by a team of subject experts to assess, analyse and interpret their levels to get admission into COEs.
- 6. Candidates may be asked questions to know the reasons for choosing the particular coaching, previous knowledge about those courses and what they want to become in future.
- 7. Candidates who wish to take coaching for IIT/JEE, NDA & NEET may be asked to solve basic problems of mathematics and physical science during the technical round (Oral interview) by Subject experts.
- 8. Once Technical round is completed the final selected students list will be sent to all 204 TMR schools and communicated to the candidates.

The entire process will be done as per the rule of reservation and norms of TMREIS. The decision of the secretary, TMREIS is the final in selecting students and allotting students in various TMR Jr. college COEs.

Allotment of Hall Ticket numbers.

Hall ticket numbers will be allotted to the candidates as per the procedure given below.

- 1. Hall ticket number bears Alpha code followed by 2 digit Erstwhile District code followed 2 digit test centre code and 4 digit number.
- 2. Alpha Code stands for name of the Intensive integrated coaching given below followed by eight digit number first two digit stands for erstwhile District Code, second two digits stands for Examination centre code as given below then last four digit number stands for number allotted to the candidates starting from 0001.
